

**Coral like fungi. Clavariaceae**

**Single or branched erect clubs. Smooth hymenium on upper parts.**

**Often brightly coloured.**

**Genera include:**

<i>Clavulina</i>	<b>bisterigmate basidia</b>
<i>Clavaria</i>	<b>simple clubs, seldom branched</b>
<i>Clavicornona</i>	<b>candelabra type branching</b>
<i>Clavulinopsis</i>	<b>thin branched clubs</b>
<i>Ramaria</i>	<b>thick branched clumps, brown spores</b>
<i>Typhula</i>	<b>small, slender clubs.</b>
<i>Aphelaria</i>	<b>dense flattened branches</b>

***Aphelaria sp.***

**Fruit body.** Coralloid fungus with dense many forked , flattened branches. Grows on soil.

**Spore print.** White

**Habitat.** On soil.

***Clavaria miniata now called Clavulinopsis sulcata***

Division Eumycota Subdivision Basidiomycotina Class Homobasidiomycetes Order Aphyllophorales

**Fruit body.** Up to 100 mm tall, mostly unforked, cylindrical to slightly flattened with a longitudinal groove. Bright reddish orange.

**Spore print.** White.

**Habitat.** On soil in the rainforest areas.

***Clavicornona colensoi***

Division Eumycota Subdivision Basidiomycotina Class Homobasidiomycetes Order Aphyllophorales

**Fruit body.** Club fungus branching into smaller branches and finally ending in a small cup with four to six much smaller crown - like terminal branches .

**Colour .** Off white to pale tan.

**Spores print.** White.

**Habitat.** On wood

***Clavaria zollingeri***

Division Eumycota Subdivision Basidiomycotina Class Homobasidiomycetes Order Aphyllophorales

**Fruit bodies.** Branching , cylindrical , violet coloured, fragile, to 7.5 cm.

**Spore print** White.

**Habitat.** On soil amongst leaf litter.

***Pterula multifida***

Division Eumycota Subdivision Basidiomycotina Class Homobasidiomycetes Order Aphyllophorales

**Fruit body.** Slender branched coral-like fungus with pointed tips.

**Colour.** White.

**Spore print .** White.

**Habitat.** On old wood or bark.

***Clavaria sp. 1***

Division Eumycota Subdivision Basidiomycotina Class Homobasidiomycetes Order Aphyllophorales

**Fruit body.** Simple clubs, 30-50 mm tall x 2 mm diameter. Apex bluntly rounded, pure white, in dense clusters.

**Spore print .** White

**Habitat.** On soil

***Clavaria sp. 2***

Division Eumycota Subdivision Basidiomycotina Class Homobasidiomycetes Order Aphyllophorales

**Fruit body.** Simple clubs, 30-50mms x 3mm diameter, rounded apex, orange.

**Spore print.** White

**Habitat.** On soil, growing in clusters.

***Clavaria sp. 3***

Division Eumycota Subdivision Basidiomycotina Class Homobasidiomycetes Order Aphyllophorales

**Fruit body.** Coralloid, 30 mm tall, white, dividing up to four times, ultimate tips acute.

**Spore print.** White.

**Habitat.** On wood.
