

## Fungi with teeth (Order Aphyllophorales)

### *Hydnum repandum*

Eumycota Subdivision Basidiomycotina Class Homobasidiomycetes Order Aphyllophorales

**Cap.** Contorted convex to flat or repand, creamy white to pale orange.

**Spines.** Concolorous with the cap, up to 5 mm long, adnate to decurrent.

**Stem.** Cream, staining brown.

**Spore print.** White.

**Habitat.** On soil

### *Phellodon niger*

Eumycota Subdivision Basidiomycotina Class Homobasidiomycetes Order Aphyllophorales

**Fruit body.** Flat to funnel shaped tough cap, faintly zoned in grey to brown. The undersurface has bluish grey spines. The stem is brown, tough and densely felty.

**Spore print .** White.

**Habitat.** On soil.

### *Sarcodon sp*

Subdivision Basidiomycotina Class Homobasidiomycetes Order Aphyllophorales

**Fruit Body.** Tough, toothed fruiting body with a cap and stipe. Upper surface dark brown to blackish.

**Spines.** Pale with lilac tint, becoming brown with age.

**Stipe.** Concolorous with cap.

**Habitat.** On soil,  
Ectomycorrhzal.
